Eurriculum News

Math

- Finish Geometry:
- Students will identify points, lines, line segments, rays, angles, perpendicular and parallel lines.
- Students will identify and draw one or more lines of symmetry for 2D figures.
- Students will apply knowledge of right angles to identify acute, right, and obtuse angles.
- Students will classify 2D figures
- Students will illustrate and measure angles using a protractor.
- Begin Personal Financial Literacy

Reading

- Students will establish purpose for reading a selected text.
- Students will ask literal, interpretive and evaluative questions of text.
- Students will monitor and adjust reading comprehension using background knowledge, creating sensory images, and generating questions.

Writing

- We will continue to "Write to Explain" as we work on expository writing fluency; create compositions that establish a central idea, include supporting sentences with facts, details and explanations, and contain a concluding statement.
- We will elaborate to improve our writing using revising and editing strategies.
